

New State Boating Certificate Registration:

Effective, 01 DEC 2012, the State of CT implemented a new plan to allow students to go to the State web site and pay for and print their own Certificate upon completion of a State approved course.

This applies to all classes, US Coast Guard Auxiliary or otherwise.

The basic procedure is as follows:

1. Prior to attending the class, the student will obtain, at no cost, from the State a "Connecticut Conservation ID number." That number automatically places the student's information into the State of CT system. This currently is the same system that allows CT residents to obtain hunting and fishing licenses.

*** Any one that currently has a hunting or fishing license will already have the number.

2. The student will need to provide the Flotilla with that number on the day of the class.

3. If the student passes the test at the end of the class, the Flotilla will submit on-line to the State "the pass" on that students ID number.

4. The student will then be able to go to State web site, pay the \$50.00 fee by credit card and print his/her Certificate. (Generally within 72 hours).
